Season tickets cost **£35** per person. Sign up at the coffee morning, first concert, or contact us at any other time.

Season ticket holder benefits:

- ✓ Additional events organised during the year, such as trips to opera and ballet performances (cost extra)

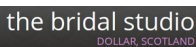

The duo have recorded their debut album, including works by Janacek,

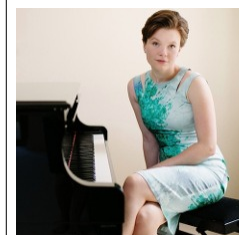
Fauré and Chopin.
